

## Dissemination activities in Poland

Dissemination activities were carried out in Poland by IWR and ODMT throughout the project implementation period, and especially after the completion of the main results.

Online activities were conducted - social media posts, articles on websites, maintenance of the project website and e-learning platform.

After the training course in Gdynia, the participants from Poland with the support of partner organizations implemented 3 activities: on-site training for youth workers, online training for youth workers and workshops for young people.

### Training for youth workers

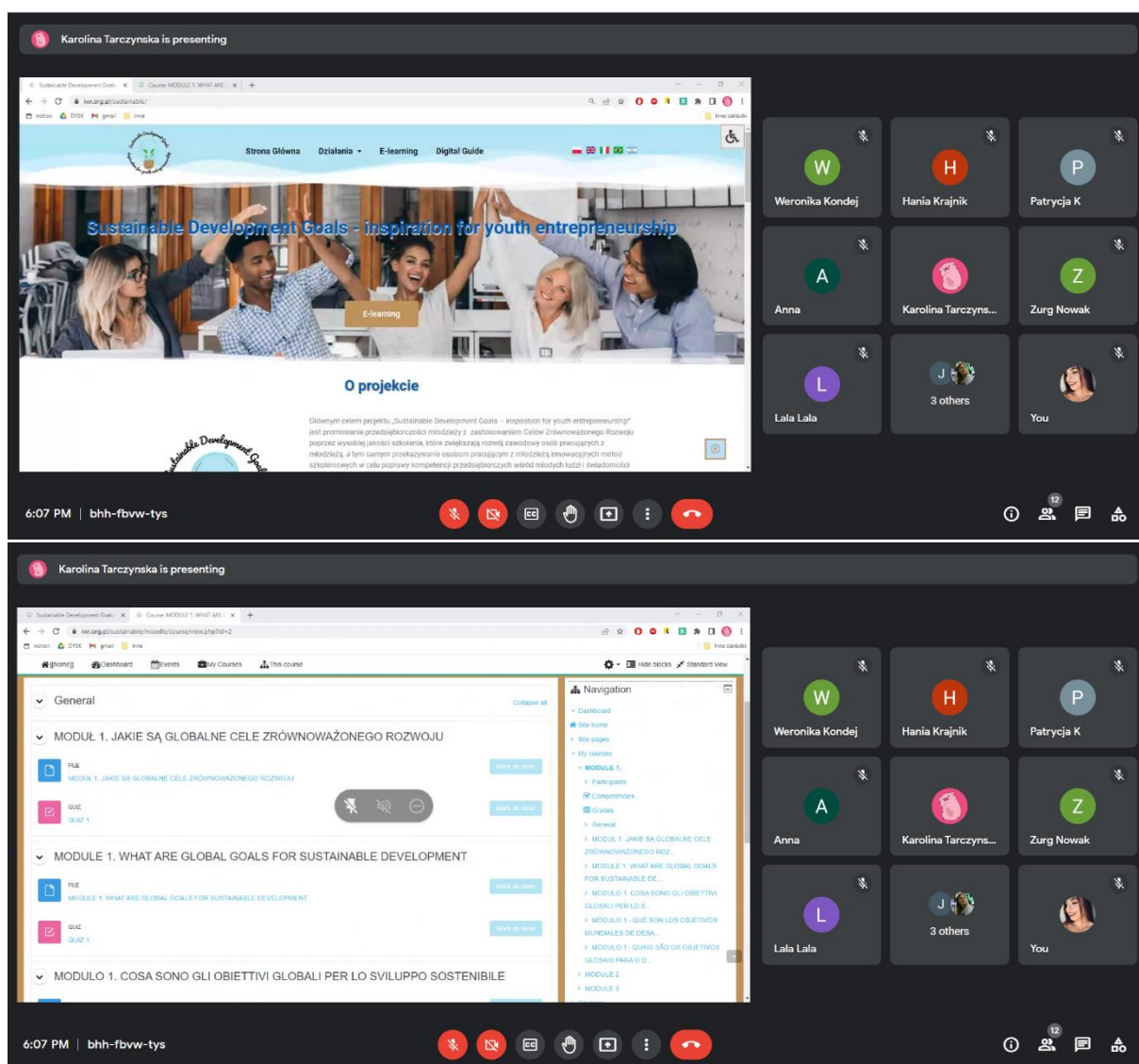
On May 30, 2022, a Stationary Training Course was implemented, aimed at youth workers associated with IWR and ODMT, as well as other organizations and institutions working together in the local area.

The training was attended by 6 people. during the training the website, e-learning platform and ways to use these tools in youth work were presented. In addition, the participants, using the developed materials, attempted to develop and plan further local activities for young people and prepare young people to participate in exchanges in Italy and Poland.



## On-line training for youth workers

An online training course aimed at youth workers from the Pomeranian Voivodeship was organized on June 2. It was attended by 12 people. During the several-hour training, participants got acquainted with the e-learning course, the content of the modules and solved quizzes to test their knowledge. During the meeting, the presenter showed how to use the platform and went through the registration steps together with the participants. She also briefly presented the content found in each module. This was followed by an exercise using the content of the modules. After which, each participant was tasked with selecting one module, reading its content in detail, and solving a quiz found in the module. As a result, the participants further assimilated the functionality of the platform. At the end of the training, participants brainstormed how to use the e-learning course in their work.
